Weekly Current Events Assignment

1. Find a current article that involves STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math). As the semester progresses, this will become easier as you learn about things that relate to STEAM. It must have a <u>publish date</u> on it, and be within the last two weeks. You are free to choose subjects that you are interested in. Mr. Miller or Mr. Westfall may give you a theme for the week.

2. It can come from the Internet, a magazine, or the newspaper. If you want to try a different source, get it approved by me first.

3. <u>Read it</u>, (this is important!) and write a brief 4 sentence summary about the article. Also, state which branch of STEAM it best pertains to and why.

4. Copy the article, or cut it out of the newspaper. Glue, tape, or staple it onto a neat sheet of notebook paper. Have this finished BEFORE you come to class on the day it is due. Full credit will not be given to those students who do not complete this assignment outside of class.

5. Mark the current event week number on the provided map, and paperclip it to your assignment. You will use the same map and log each week.

6. Fill out the current event log and paper clip to your assignment each week. You will use the same log each week. This includes 4 vocab words from the article, and their definition.

7. This will be due every week until the end of the semester, usually on Fridays.

8. When you are ready to turn in your current event, go through this checklist before submitting.

- Is your name, period, and current number (matches the week number, on board in front of room) on the top of the paper?
- Does your paper include the article?
- Does your paper include the summary?
- Does your summary state which branch of STEAM the article addresses? (It could be more than one!)
- Did you mark the week number on the map look up your 4 vocab words with definitions?
- Is it ready to turn in, staples and all, when you come to class on Friday, with map and log?
